Learning outcomes

By the end of this course students should be able to analyze and valuate corporations. The students will also learn about corporate transactions, reasons and process of mergers & acquisitions as well as the field of private equity, its different types and the dynamics of the investment process in private equity. The course will strengthen empirical understanding of the subject and enhance the development of critical thinking skills. The written assignment of the

course will support writing and analytical skills.

Teaching methods

Lectures 12 h and case study.

Content

Mergers and acquisitions, corporate valuation, free cash flows, cost of capital, business evaluation, private equity field and its types, dynamics of returns in private equity cases like leveraged buy-outs (LBO), investment process for private equity in general and private equity case.
